This is Quang Van Nguyen (male) - Born December 26, 1997, Quang arrived at the HADC on March 15, 2005. He has cerebral palsy due to encephalitis. Quang, with his radiating smile, can move and make sounds to express his emotions. Quang, like the other residents, is being cared for by Catholic Sisters on limited resources available in this impoverished area. He and the other residents are in dire need of food and new beds which are a necessity for sanitary and rehabilitation purposes.
